These courses provide you with a streamlined and efficient way to become recertified *if your license as a CNA or LNA has lapsed*, and you wish to become recertified in your state or you just want to refresh your caregiving skills to build confidence in your skill set.

After approximately three weeks you will be entitled to show your understanding of caregiving principles and display your abilities during an online conversation and evaluation with an experienced CNA/LNA instructor.

If you are in a qualifying state, you will be able to apply for relicensure following successful completion of this online evaluation with your instructor.

You will be watching how-to videos on all the different caregiving skills which you can rewatch until you feel comfortable with performing all aspects of each skill. Note packages are also provided for you to review and study when you have available time.

Online classes are two hours in length and are scheduled in the evening, twice a week. Here you will get to know other experienced caregivers with expired licenses like yourself as well as caregivers just wishing to improve their skills.

Classes are fun, engaging, and full of great caregiving stories and helpful tips and techniques. During the online sessions you are encouraged to share your caregiving "gems" as well.
